## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MASTER CLASS / EARLY STAGE RESEARCHERS CLASS / e-POSTER SESSION $7^{th}$ IMSPC\*

## I. SUBMISSION

- *I.* The condition for participation in the Master Class/ Early Stage Researchers Class/ e-Poster Session is a positive review of the submitted abstract, registration of the presenting author and payment of the conference participation fee.
- **2.** The Master Class/ Early Stage Researchers Class/e-Poster Session accepts original and casuistic as well as meta- analyses of research findings.

Work should be prepared in the English language. Presentation of work in the Master Class/Early Stage Researchers Class/Poster Session takes place in the English language only. Each participant can submit up to 2 proposals.

- **3.** Abstracts (MS Word file, pages file) should be sent by e-mail to **msp.poster@wsm.opole.pl**, topic "Master Class/e-Poster Session 7<sup>th</sup> IMSPC", with the following layout:
  - name
  - authors (full name and surname of the author/co-author/co-authors)
  - the representative (full name)
  - e-mail and telephone number of representative
  - institution (full name of the institution to the author and each of the co-authors are affiliated, city, country)
  - keywords (maximum 6 words); ); keywords should be taken from the Medical Subject Headings 2020 catalogue, available at: https://meshb.nlm.nih.gov/search
  - summary (broken into 5 parts: introduction, aim, material and methods, results and conclusions); please do not include citations, figures, drawings and photographs in the abstract.
  - abstracts should be written in Times New Roman 12 pt. font, using single line spacing

The length of the abstract (not including the title, author/co-author/co-authors names and affiliations) must not exceed 2200 characters (with spaces) or 300 words.

- 4. Abstracts sent later or to a different e-mail than specified above will not be accepted.
- 5. Abstract submission assumes permission to present the work from all co-authors and the facility director from where the work originates. In addition, the author submitting the abstract is obliged to send, together with the text, a completed and signed consent for the publication of the abstract in the post-conference book of abstracts. This consent should be signed by all co-authors of the work on one page.
- 6. Authors whose submissions receive a positive review of the e-Poster Session Jury and are qualified for presentation during the Master Class/Early Stage Researchers Class/e-Poster Session of the Conference will be notified by the organisers via e-mail no later than 20 April 2020.
- 7. Papers based on presentations with the highest scores will be published in subsequent issues of Medical Science Pulse (MSHE 20 points; IC 100.00). The condition for the publication is that the authors send full-text works to the editorial panel of the quarterly Medical Science Pulse and obtain two positive reviews.

- 8. For the presentation of the work during the Congress, the author is awarded 15 educational points.
- **9.** Submitting the summary is simultaneously an agreement by the authors to respect the Terms and Conditions.

## I II. MASTER CLASS/ EARLY STAGE RESEARCHERS CLASS/ e-POSTER EXHIBITION

- 1. Authors of selected works are obliged to prepare:
- a) in the case of Master Class/ Early Stage Researchers Class: 1 slide (.ppt, landscape orientation) with the main assumption of the work, purpose, methodology, results and conclusions; the content should be written in English.
- b) in the case of e-Poster Session: a legible e-poster with the target size of 70 x 100 cm (vertical orientation) in the .ppt and .jpg format
- the poster should be sent in the form of 1 slide
- the content should be written in English.
- minimum font size 8 pt. (but it is recommended to use as large as possible)
- portrait layout using a 9:16 ratio
- recommended resolution 1080/1920
- 2. Oral presentations (Master-Class, Early Stage Researchers Class) will take place on the second day of the Conference.
- 3. The poster display will take place over the entire conference. Presenting e-posters and discussions that follow are planned for the second day of the conference. Authors of all e-posters are obliged to take part in the discussions.
- 4. Authors of all oral presentations during the Master Class/ Early Stage Researchers Class will receive a diploma stating the authors, the title of the work and the place won.
- 5. The authors of the three best e-posters will receive a diploma stating the authors, the title of the work and the place won.
- 6. The Conference organiser reserves the right to change the dates of the e-Poster/Master Class/Early Stage Researchers Class Sessions.
